House Concurrent Resolution 202

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Rules)

Whereas Sergeant Travis A. Moothart was born in Corvallis, Oregon, on February 3, 1980, to Dennis and Sue Moothart; and

Whereas Sgt. Moothart grew up in Brownsville and graduated from Central Linn High School in 1998, and went on to study mechanics at Linn-Benton Community College; and

Whereas in 2000, Sgt. Moothart enlisted in the United States Army, using his knowledge of mechanics while serving in South Korea and then in Iraq; and

Whereas on January 27, 2004, Sgt. Moothart was killed by a roadside bomb in Al Khalidiya, Iraq; and

Whereas Sgt. Moothart is remembered for his passion for family and friends, the two things he valued most; and

Whereas Sgt. Moothart is survived by his 13-year-old son, Owen, his brother, Ben, his sister, Tracy, and his parents; and

Whereas to honor Sgt. Moothart, the Moothart family awards the Travis A. Moothart Memorial Scholarship every year at the Central Linn High School graduation; and

Whereas the Brownsville American Legion Post has been named after Sgt. Moothart; now, therefore,

That we, the members of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Sergeant Travis A. Moothart for his service to his country.
